

Audition Registration – Committee Signup

Parent volunteers are the backbone of our organization, averaging 20-30 hours each on a production. Therefore, **all cast parents or guardians must provide substantial service in order to have their children participate.** For families with more than one cast member, equivalent additional adult volunteer service is required.

Parental help is mandatory for all CTE actors (Grades 2 through 9).

FVTC actors (Grade 9 through age 20 years) may have parental assistance or donate their own time and talent on committees.

Please select as follows from the committees listed below and indicate which family member will be doing the work:

From Group A: One (1) committee OR Whichever;

OR: From Group B one (1) committee AND from Group C one (1) committee.

We will do our best to honor your selections, but reserve the right to make adjustments as needed as show requirements may vary.

(Note: Online options for each committee include marking a box to indicate "I am willing to chair a committee" as well as which family member (father, mother, or student) will assist with the committee.)

Group A

Cast Management: Keep actors under control and make sure dressing rooms are kept clean during rehearsals, tech week, and shows.

Costume Construction and Organization: Help with sewing, assembling, repairing, and organizing costumes before and during shows.

Set Construction, Move-in and Strike: Build the set under the direction of the head carpenter. Help move it in and out of venue and assemble and disassemble it and return to storage.

Whichever: Assign me to whichever committees need me the most. (Leave the rest blank.)

Group B

Concessions: Set up and sell treats, beverages, and memorabilia during at least three (3) shows.

Hair and Makeup: Be at all tech week rehearsals and a minimum of three (3) shows to style hair and apply makeup. Help assemble and inventory hair and make-up supplies.

House Management: Help direct patrons to their seats or to the restrooms, distribute programs, and be available to handle patron needs during three (3) shows.

Props: Help gather, create, organize, and repair props needed for the play, and assist with them during tech week and shows.

Stage Crew: Move sets on and off of the stage during tech week and a minimum of three (3) shows.

Tech Crew: Help operate video, microphones, and the follow spot light board for all shows.

Group C

Cast Board: Create cast picture boards with captions for the lobby during public shows.

Cast Party: Help get supplies and serve food at the cast party or parties.

Publicity: Assist with distribution and placement of flyers and posters for placement in area locations. Work with CTE Publicity Coordinator on press releases and electronic postings.

Set Painting: Paint the set under the direction of the set designer.
